We will create our pieces on the first night. They will be fired the next day before we meet. We will antique and polish them the second night.

We will address the use of Mason underglaze stains for coloring this pure white clay. Once colored, we will use our colored porcelain to marble, inlay and make canes of color and learn to stain or paint on the work before a glaze fire. Students can expect Katie to guide them through any challenge. We will be using pinch, slab and coil methods as well as some other specific methods for handling the unique properties of porcelain. Advanced students are also generous in sharing processes as they create their own special pieces. Translucency is one quality that gives a magic to porcelain. Join this Monday group of creative people as we share visions and scheme to bring those plans to reality.
